Year 1 have had a pyjama day to celebrate positive behaviour that they have been showing in class.

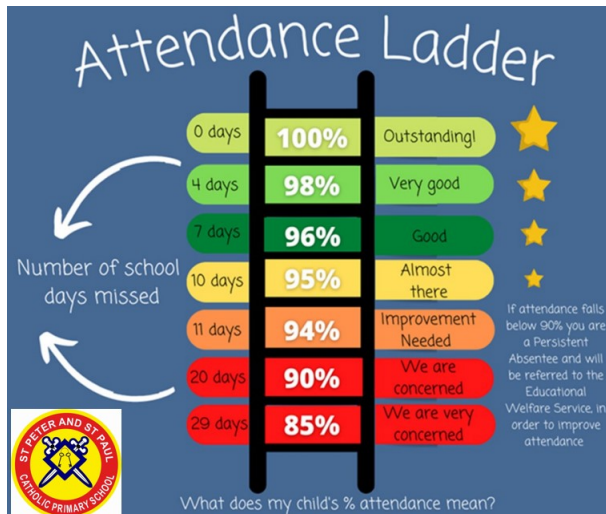
Year 4 have been to the National Horse racing museum to mark the Holocaust, and had a morning session at Newmarket Academy based around Science.

Year 5/6 have been involved in a Athletics tournament at Newmarket Academy which they really enjoyed.

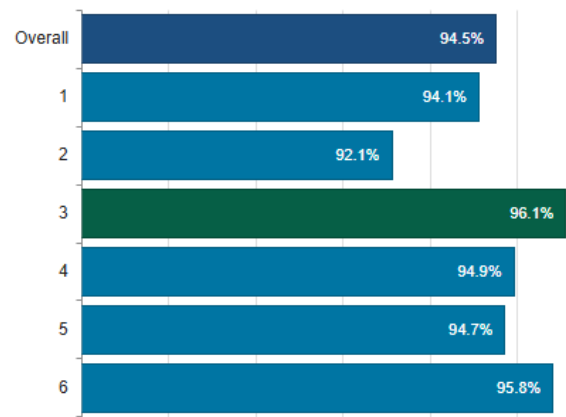
Year 6 are working really hard on the curriculum to ensure they are ready for secondary school and SATs, thank you to those children who are staying after school for some boosters.
