We will have a special collective worship to start the day and children will be learning about different light festivals as part of their BRAVE (RE) work.

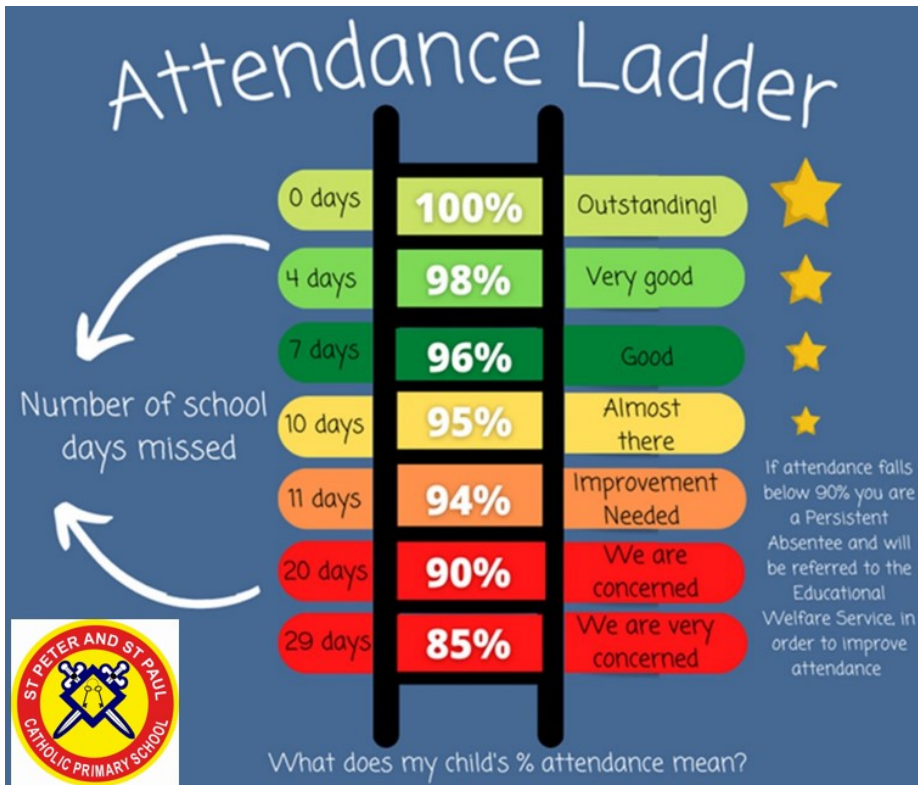
Poppies and other merchandise will be available from the school office from 4/11/24. All of the donations received goes to The Royal British Legion, who worked hard to support military members & their families past and present.
