Please think about where you are parking to drop your children at school— Please park legally and responsibly outside of school.

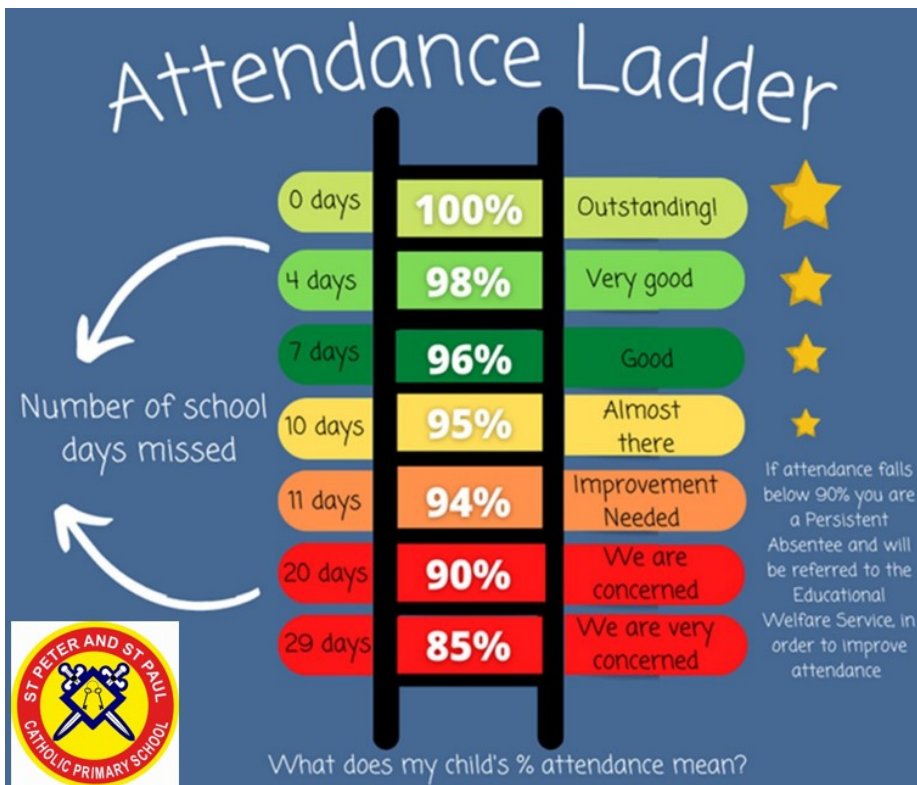
Walking home permission.
