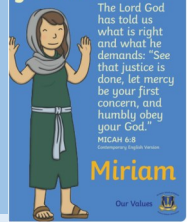

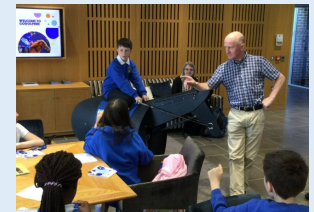
Pony Academy

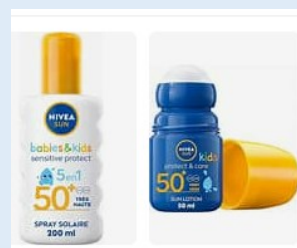
Year R trip to Lackford Lakes
